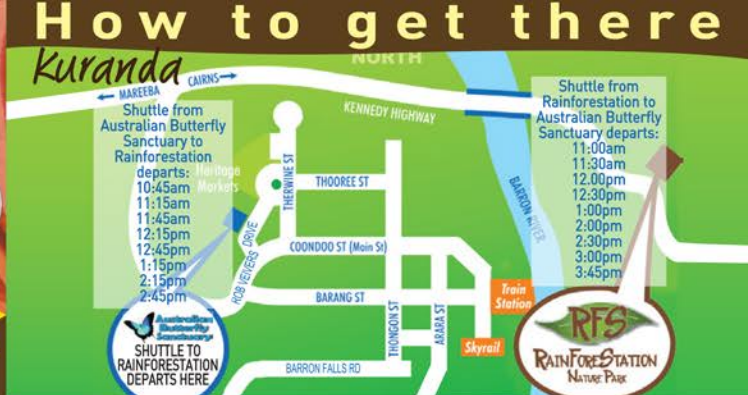


Join your Pamagirri Aboriginal Guide on our Bush Tucka Walk – an in-depth and interactive experience in some of the oldest rainforest in the world. After a traditional welcome and smoking blessing around a fire, your guide will show you plants, fruits and berries that were traditionally used as food and remedies. You will also learn about Aboriginal huts (gunyas) and how they were constructed as well as traditional artefacts and implements such as hook boomerangs and stone axes.

Departs daily 1pm. Also available as part of Tropic Wings R1BP day tour. The walk is along an even path on undulating ground. Moderate fitness required. Comfortable walking shoes recommended.

Rainforestation is situated on the Kennedy Highway at the top of the Kuranda Range, five minutes from Kuranda Village, and half an hour from Cairns in Tropical North Queensland. A regular shuttle bus service operates between the Australian Butterfly Sanctuary in Kuranda and Rainforestation - \$12 Return, \$7 One Way per Adult.

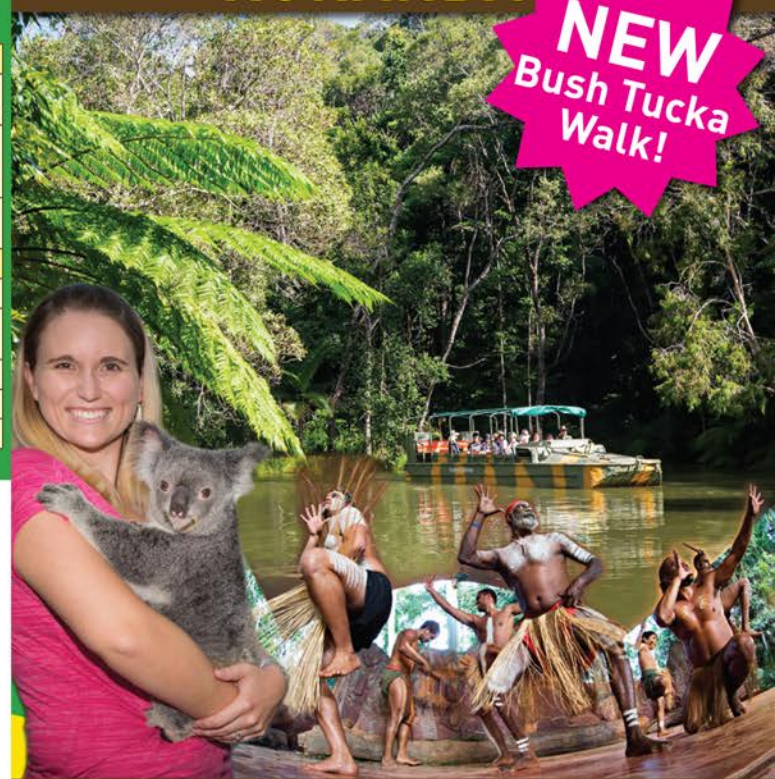

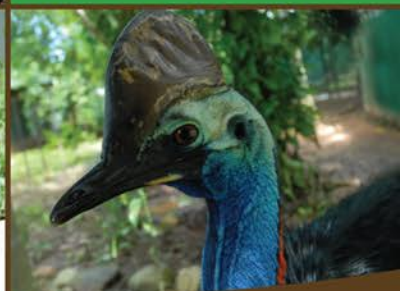

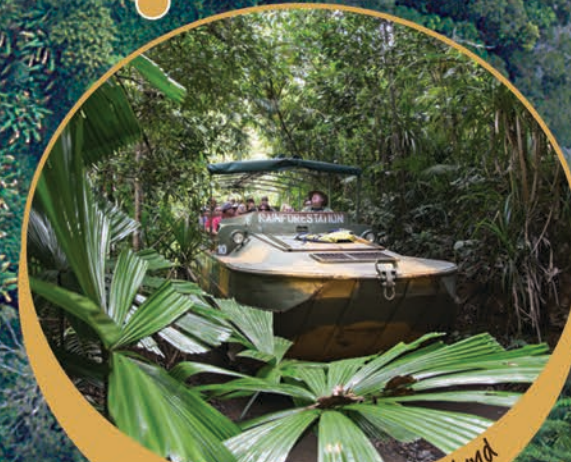
